

OVERVIEW

Thyroid nodules affect up to two-thirds of the general population, with 7–15% of identified nodules found to be thyroid cancers. The number of thyroid nodules investigated and subsequently diagnosed is constantly increasing due to accidental findings during imaging procedures performed for non-thyroid disorders. It is therefore crucial to correctly stratify the malignancy risk of nodules. Key opinion leaders in thyroid disorders will discuss the most appropriate strategies to handle clinical cases and the most recent advances in differential diagnosis of thyroid nodules.

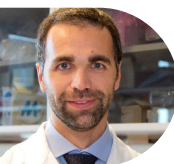


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
